Listed on the LoAR as *Cleft Lands, Barony of the* in the registration of a badge, their name first appears on an LoAR as *Cleftlands, Barony of the*, in conjunction with the August 1979 registration of their arms.

Aiden Elfäedur. Name correction from Aiden Alfeadur for House Lalaiel.

Listed on the LoAR as  $Aiden\ \underline{\underline{Alfea}}dur$  in the registration of his badge, his name was registered as  $Aiden\ \underline{\underline{Elfae}}dur$  on the May 1983 LoAR.

# **MERIDIES**

Monford Allheisen. Reblazon of badge. Azure, two trident heads shafts crossed in saltire Or.

The LoAR said that this was a reblazon of his device; in fact, this is a reblazon of his badge, registered as *Azure, two demi-tridents in saltire Or* on the February 1983 LoAR.

The LoAR failed to note that this was a change of holding name. His holding name, Domhnall Broyces, is released.

His previous device, *Azure, three sackbuts, a bordure argent*, is hereby retained as a badge, associated with the household name *Neuschel Consort of Musicke*, registered on the November 2001 LoAR.

The erroneously retained device, Azure, three sackbuts inverted within a bordure argent, is released.

The LoAR failed to note that this was a change of the holding name Anne of Calafia, registered April 2004. Her holding name is released.

Joan Sutton. Name change from Æflæd of the Weald.

The LoAR failed to note that this was a change of name. Her previous name, Æflæd of the Weald, is retained as an alternate name.

Listed on the LoAR as *Rhonwen Y Clermwnt o'r Mwntduog* in the reblazoning of her arms, her name was registered as *Rhonwen Y Clermont o'r Mwntduog* on the March 1987 LoAR.

Giudo di Niccolo Brunelleschi. Blazon correction. Purpure, a pale argent surmounted by a slip of willow bendwise sinister throughout Or.

This was blazoned on the LoAR as *Purpure*, a pale argent surmounted a slip of willow bendwise sinister throughout Or, omitting the by.
