Her previous device, registered in August 1979 and reblazoned in April 2002 as Argent, semy of shamrocks vert, a mouse rampant sable maintaining an Irish harp Or stringed vert, is retained as a badge.

When her second name was submitted, the submitter neglected to note that it was a name change, not a new name. The error was caught recently by the submitter, and so we are correcting it now. Her previous name, *Eilionora inghean Domhnaill*, is released.

Josce de Bretaingne. Name.

Listed on the LoAR as a name change from *Gwillim Kynith*, this submission is not from the same person. The legal names on the submission forms are quite different. The confusion arose because Josce originally tried to submit the name *Gwilim Kynith*, which was returned in October 2005 for conflict with Gwillim, and a commenter mentioned this when the name Josce was submitted. *Gwillim Kynith* should be a primary name, not an alternate name for Josce, and the armory currently registered to Josce, *Or, a coney and a fox combatant within an orle gules*. should be associated with Gwillim, not Josce.

April 2015

Sunnifa in hialtlenzka Tókadóttir. Device change. Argent, in fess a mouse sejant erect contourny sable playing on a harp reversed proper.

Listed on the LoAR as a new device, the LoAR failed to note that she already had a device registered from August 1982. Her previous device, *Per pale sable and vert, a mouse sejant erect playing an Irish harp argent*, is retained as a badge.

June 2016

Fáelán t{0,}lusmiðr. Device. Sable, a furison and in chief three mullets of eight points argent.

Appearing on the LoAR as $F\'{a}el\'{a}n\ tolerander$, the proper spelling of the registered name is $F\'{a}el\'{a}n\ t\{o,\}lusmi\~{o}r$.
