

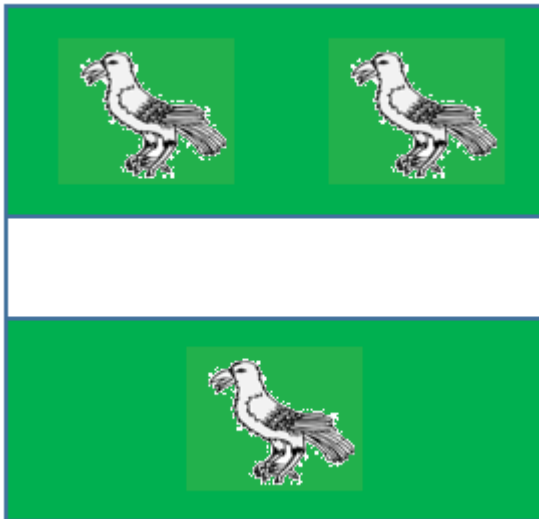

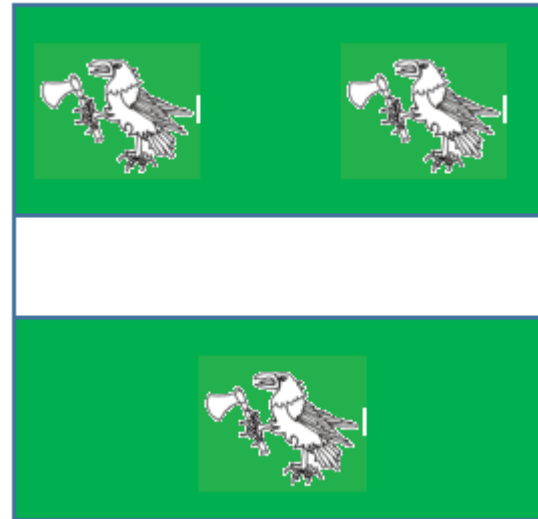

SENA Appendix I – Charge Group Theory

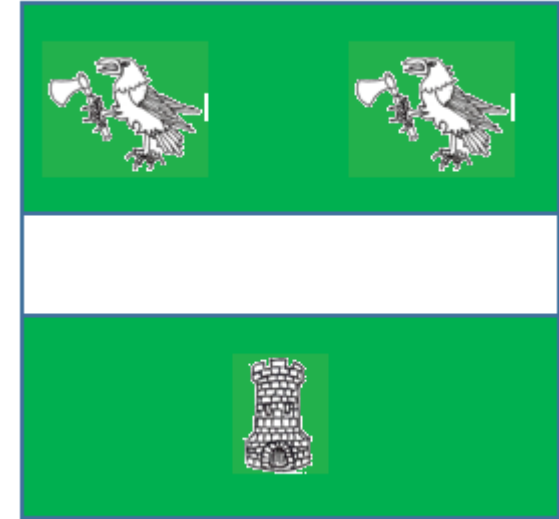
- Secondary charges may have maintained charges. Those maintained charges are considered part of the same secondary charge group as the maintaining charges.



Vert, a fess between three ravens argent has a single secondary charge group with three charges (the ravens).



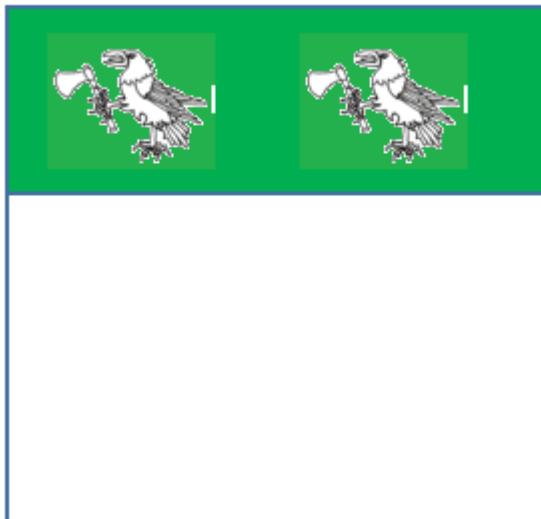
Vert, a fess between three ravens each maintaining an axe argent has a single secondary charge group with six charges (the ravens and axes).



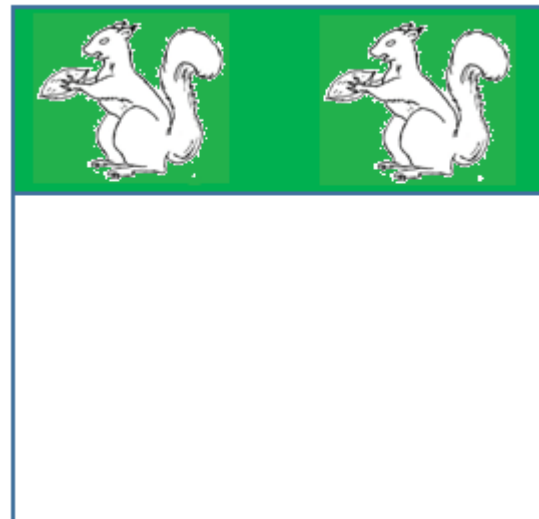
Vert, a fess between two ravens each maintaining an axe and a tower argent has a single secondary charge group with five charges (the ravens, axes, and tower). This isn't registerable because there are three types of charges in the secondary group.

SENA Appendix I – Charge Group Theory

- Tertiary charges may have maintained charge if that charge is closely associated with the charge maintaining it. A list of these combination will be in section F of Appendix I. The maintained charges will not contribute to difference.

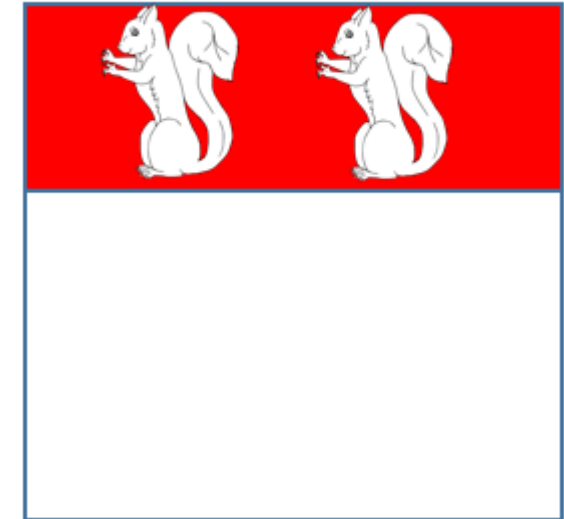
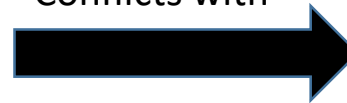


Argent, on a chief two ravens each maintaining an axe argent is not allowable as a raven maintaining an axe isn't in the new section (F) of Appendix I.



Argent, on a chief two squirrels each maintaining a nut argent is allowable as a squirrel maintaining a nut is in the new section (F) of Appendix I.

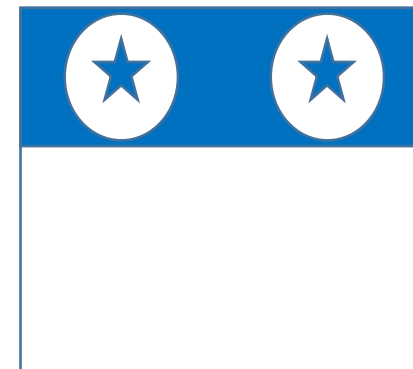
Conflict with a single DC for changing the tincture of the chief as the maintained nut does not contribute to difference.

SENA Appendix I – Charge Group Theory

- Quaternary charges are registerable only as part of an augmentation or under an Individually Attested Pattern (IAP). They do not count for difference. This confirms existing precedent.



Sable, on a chevron Or between three gryphon's heads erased argent a crescent between two escallops azure and on a chief argent three torteaux each charged with a fleur-de-lys Or was registered to Juliana de Luna in July 2010. It would be registrable under the updated Appendix I as it was accepted under an IAP.



*Barring an IAP, Argent, on a chief azure two plates each charged with a mullet azure is **not registerable** because of the quaternary mullets. **HOWEVER:** Argent, on a chief azure two plates and for augmentation each plate charged with a mullet azure is **registerable** even though it is the same design because in this case the mullets are an augmentation.*

From the LoAR: Names

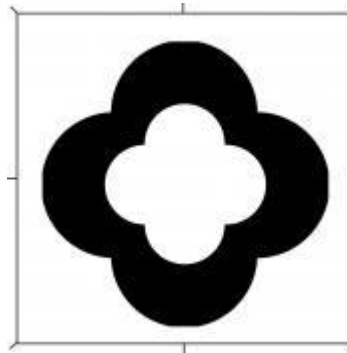
- In registering the names *Ciaran mac Mael Caemgein Ui Chonchobair* and *Uilliam mac Máel Cáemgein Uí Chonchobair* [A-An Tir] the July 2004 precedent that we do not regulate claims to be siblings was upheld.
- In registering the name *Sign of the Vaire Masculyn* the March 2020 precedent that allows single-word fur tinctures (such as *ermine*, *vair*, and *pean*) to be used in order names and heraldic titles was extended to the use of such tinctures in household names. From the LoAR: Armory

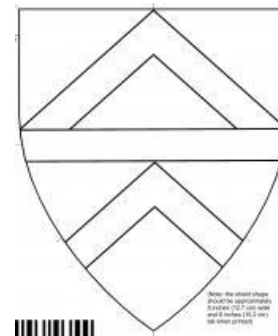
- Ruled that there is at least a DC between a *lunel* and a *quatrefoil voided* [Elionora inghean Ui Cheallaigh, A-Ansteorra]
 - Note: A *quatrefoil voided* is registrable only by the Existing Registration Allowance; precedent allowing the voiding and fimbriation of trefoils and quatrefoils is overturned in this registration.
- The motif *a fess between two chevrons* is considered three co-primary charges. It has a DC from *three chevrons* as changing the inner chevron to a fess was used as a cadency step in period. [Evelun Lambert, A-Ansteorra]

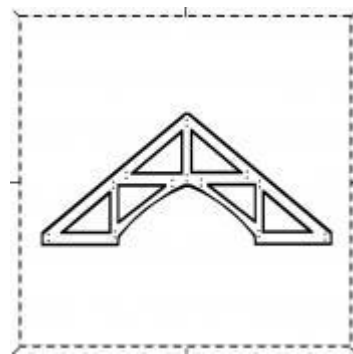
