## **Scheduling and Status Information**

The July Wreath meeting was held on July 10. The July Pelican meeting was held on July 25.

The August Pelican and Wreath meetings were held as a series of mini-meetings at Pennsic. Wreath and Pelican held a joint meeting in the greater Washington D.C. area on September 25-26, with Wreath holding another meeting in advance on September 11. The October meetings for both Wreath and Pelican were held the last weekend of October. The November Pelican meeting was held November 20. The November Wreath meeting was held on November 13, with a continuation scheduled for November 26. The December Pelican and Wreath meetings were held December 18.
