

Errata

These are corrections to previous LoARs.

September 1973

WEST

Vivian of the Moon. Name change from Vivianne of the Moon and device change. Purpure, in base a crescent argent below three Lotus blossoms argent.

Her old name, *Vivianne of the Moon*, registered in June 1973, is released.

Her old device, *Argent, on a lozenge sable a crescent argent*, registered in June 1973, is retained as a badge.

Listed on the LoAR as new actions, they were in fact changes of previously registered items.

January 1985

EAST

Cynedd ap Gwen. Name and badge. Sable, a sun eclipsed within a bordure argent.

Listed on the LoI as "name and badge", the LoAR listed only the badge acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

March 1985

CALONTIR

Geoffri of Wareine. Name.

This personal name was listed on the LoI along with a household name and badge submission. The LoAR mistakenly listed only the household name and badge acceptances. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the personal the name was also accepted at that time.

EAST

Sine ni Mhoraig. Name and device. Per chevron vert and sable, two mullets of eight points and a linden tree eradicated argent.

Listed on the LoI as "name and device", the LoAR listed only the device acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

May 1986

MIDDLE

Alphia Biraz-pars. Name change from Alphia Bonadea and device change. Sable, a natural leopard's head couped Or marked sable.

Listed on the LoAR as a device, the name change was not mentioned in the LoAR, as was usual for those days.

Her old name, *Alphia Bonadea*, is released.

Her old device, *Sable, a leopard's head couped Or, fimbriated ermine*, is released

January 1987

WEST

Geoffrey of Clan Fergus. Name and device. Azure, an axe, head to sinister, argent and a gore sinister Or.

Listed on the LoI as "name and device", the LoAR listed only the device acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

March 1988

WEST

Vivian of the Moon. Name correction from Vivienne of the Moon.

Listed on the LoAR as *Vivienne of the Moon* in the reblazon of her device, her name was registered as *Vivian of the Moon* on the September 1973 LoAR.

November 1989

MIDDLE

Geoffrey of Coldingham. Name and device. Per bend Or and gules, crusilly patency Or, in sinister chief a demi-lion sable, collared Or.

Listed on the LoI as "name and device", the LoAR listed only the device acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

March 1990

EAST

Julitta de Moulins. Name and device. Per pall ermine, sable and gules, in fess an owl close affronty and an increscent moon argent.

Listed on the LoI as "name and device", the LoAR listed only the device acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

December 1990

ATLANTIA

Fionngula O'Rourke. Name and device. Per pale wavy sable and ermine, a plate and a pellet, each charged with a swan naiant respectant, counterchanged.

Listed on the LoI as "name and device", the LoAR listed only the device acceptance. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time.

January 1991

MERIDIES

Randal mac Ruadháin. Name correction from Randall Mac Ruadaín.

Listed on the LoAR as *Randall Mac Ruadaín* in the registration of his device, his name was registered as *Randal mac Ruadháin* on the November 1990 LoAR.

February 1992

CAID

Andrew Drexler. Name correction from Andrew Dexter.

Listed on the LoAR as *Andrew Dexter* in the registration of his badge, his name was registered as *Andrew Drexler* on the November 1984 LoAR.

December 1992

ATENVELDT

Richard Stewart. Name.

A device under this name was returned on the December 1992 LoAR, but the name acceptance was inadvertently left off the LoAR. The name form in the paperwork is marked as accepted with a date stamp of December 1992. While not stated explicitly on the LoAR, the name was accepted at that time. His device was registered in August 1993.

August 2001

MERIDIES

Alessandra di Fiore. Name correction from Alessandra di Fióre.

Listed on the LoAR as *Alessandra di Fióre* in the registration of her badge, her name was registered as *Alessandra di Fiore* earlier on the same letter.

April 2005

OUTLANDS

Gary of Caerthe. Holding name and device. Gyronny vert and argent, a horse rampant Or within a bordure counterchanged.

The device was registered under the name *Ashi'al Külüjin*. That name had been returned in March 2005.

May 2005

ÆTHELMEARC

Muirenn ingen uí Muirchertaig. Name correction from Muireann ingen uí Muirchertaig.

Listed on the LoAR as *Muireann ingen uí Muirchertaig* in the registration of her device, her name was registered as *Muirenn ingen uí Muirchertaig* on the February 2005 LoAR.

September 2009

ATLANTIA

Cian mac Cellacháin hUí Dublaich. Name correction from Cian mac Cellacháin hUí Dhublaich.

The entry for this name on the LoAR had a typo. The discussion should have read:

Submitted as *Cian mac Ceallacháin Uí Dubhlaich*, the spelling *Dubhlaich* is a hybrid form mixing Middle Irish and Early Modern Irish orthographies. The submitter indicated that if the name had to be changed, he cared most about 10th-12th C Irish language/culture. For this period, the appropriate language is Middle Irish. If we change the clan byname to Middle Irish, the patronymic byname also needs to be Middle Irish, because the pattern *mac X + Uí Y* is a single grammatical phrase, and so must be wholly in one language per RfS III.1.a. Linguistic Consistency. A wholly Middle Irish form of the byname is *mac Cellacháin hUí Dublaich*. We have changed the name to *Cian mac Cellacháin hUí Dublaich* in order to register it. The wholly Early Modern Irish form of the name, *Cian mac Ceallacháin Uí Dhubhlaoich*, is also registerable.

October 2009

EAST

Brunissende Dragonette de Brocéliande. Name correction from Brunissende Dragonette de Broceliande and reblazon of badge correction. (Fieldless) A lantern gules paned argent.

Listed on the LoAR as a reblazon of the device of *Brunissende Dragonette de Broceliande*, the armory being reblazoned is in fact a badge, not a device, and the owner is *Brunissende Dragonette de Brocéliande*.
