When the badge was reblazoned, the LoAR listed it as a device instead of a badge.

# Hans Faust der herlat. Discussion.

The LoAR omitted discussion of the registration:

Submitted as *Hans Faust dem herlat*, the byname *dem herlat*, meaning 'the herald', is in the dative case, which would not be used in a byname. We have corrected the grammar.

# September 2002

## Ansteorra

Gisele de Bier. Name correction from Gisela de Bier.

The given name was misspelled on the LoAR.

### **East**

Moira of Northern Outpost. Device. Sable, on a chief argent a rose purpure between two roses sable.

The LoAR stated that a device was registered but omitted the blazon.

## Meridies

Willoc of Meridies. Correction of holding name from Willoc of Evensong Forest.

The group name Evensong Forest, used to form the holding name on the LoAR, is not registered.
