1. Aislinn of Loch Cairn. Holding name and device (see RETURNS for name). Per saltire vert and sable, a winged monkey segreant argent and a bordure argent semy of cinquefoils gules.

Blazoned on the LoI as *Per saltire sable and vert*, the field is actually *Per saltire vert and sable*. This is pended to allow the commenters to conflict check under the correct tinctures.

2. Edain inghean Raghalligh. Device. Vert, a hind statant contourny argent collared and chained Or, a bordure Or semy of trefoils vert. Blazoned on the LoI as *Or*, the hind is actually *argent*. This is pended to allow the commenters to conflict check under the correct tincture.
