

NPN4B2 - Non-Personal Name Presumption

- If a historic order name is important enough to protect, adding a branch name doesn't remove presumption
- Example:
 - We wouldn't register Order of the Garter of Caid since we protect Order of the Garter.

A5F – Substantial Change (SC)

- Allows a substantial difference for changes to the field for all fielded armory, not just field-primary armory.
 - Any divided field is clear of any plain field (A5F1a)





is not clear of



since multiply divided furs are considered plain tinctures for purposes of A5F1a

A5F – Substantial Change (SC)

• All armory can get an SC for substantially changing the direction of division, not just field-primary armory (A5Fb2).

since per pale is substantially different from per pale; but not clear of



since it is fieldless





A5G1 – Distinct Change (DC)

 Allows all fielded armory to receive multiple DCs changes to the field, not just field-primary armory




Appendix A – Name Patterns

Appendix K – Standard Arrangements of Charges Groups

 For purposes of determining if charges are in an allowable arrangement, two charges in saltire or three charges in a sheaf are considered a single charge. For all other purposes they are still two or three charges.






But 2 charges for conflict
