

## Tudor and Elizabethan Ship Names

This is a joint project for the simplest of reasons: we all started working on projects looking at English ship names. So we let our projects collapse into one big project. Later projects will look at Middle English ship names and ship names in other languages.

### Designators - How to Use Ship Names for Households and Groups of People

The names of ship companies - the sailors who served on a ship - are one of the models we use for household names. The form we have found them in is *(the/his) Company of the [Ship Name]* or *the [Ship Name]es Company*. Examples found in these data include:

The names of the ships themselves normally include “the” as well, though editors may not include them where the ship is discussed and the full context of a period citation not included. This article includes over 150 names of ships in the Tudor and Elizabethan royal service and the names of hundreds more private ships that were pressed into royal service, worked as privateers, or were otherwise involved with the Tudor navy.

### Patterns of Ship Names: Simple Names

One can see a variety of patterns that we used to create the names of ships. Common patterns include:

**Mottos/Desirable Traits:** The most common pattern is single words, like Advantage, Advice, Aid, Answer, and Assurance. Some are phrases: Dreadnought (dread nothing), Bonaventure, Speedwell, and Try Right. Note that newly created mottos must be shown to match the sorts of

mottos used for ship names, as the pattern of ship-name mottos is different from those used (for example) for heraldic titles.

**Charge:** The most common pattern is just the name of a heraldic charge; all seem to use the plain English name of a charge. Examples include Antelope, Bear, Dragon, Garland, Gillyflower, Harp, Hind, Moon, Pansy, Portcullis, and Sun. We also see examples of tincture+charge, and number+charge (listed below).

**Tincture+Charge:** These use the plain English form of the tincture and the charge. Examples include Black Dog, Golden Lion, Green Dragon, Red Hart, Blew Bore, and White Bear.

**Number+Charge:** Three and seven are the only numbers represented here (others are found in sign names). Examples include Seven Stars, Three Moons, and Three Ostrich Feathers.

**Given Names:** Many of these are the names of saints but others may be the names of owners or their family members. We see both male and female names. Examples include Charles, Edward, Eleanor, Jane, John, Mary, Magdalen/Mawdelyn, and Matthew.

**Saint's Names:** Some names must be understood as the names of saints as they include the word saint before the given name or another clear identification. Examples include St John the Baptist, John Evangelist, Saint George, and Our Lady.

**Classical Names:** While classical names were used in the sixteenth century as personal names, these are probably simply classical references. Examples include Achates, Neptune, and Triton. Other names, like Diana, are as likely to be a personal given name as a classical reference.

**Captain/Owner's Byname:** Some ships are named after the byname/family name of their owner or captain. Examples include Bark Aucher, Galley Blanchard, Lartique, Trego/Shalop Reneger, and the shipp of Captaine Rayonde.

**Place Name:** Most of these seem to be the name of the place they were built or are associated with; they're far more common in complex names added to another element, which are discussed below. Single-element examples include Bark of Boulogne, Bark of Cherbourg, Tremontaine, and Guiana..

**Description of Ship:** These examples fall into two types. The first is just a kind of ship: Argosy, Bark, Brigantine, Frigate, Rowbarge. While the ships are referenced in these ways, it isn't clear if the ship's crew would have been described in that way. Others are described with adjectives of color or size, like Black Bark, Black Galley, Black Pinnace, Great Bark, Small Bark, New Barke, and Red Galley. These seem to have functioned as clear names.

There are a variety of names that don't fall neatly into any of these categories. Remember that to create a pattern that would allow for the creation of new ship company names, you need to find

at least three items to argue for a new pattern and that multiple instances of a single name are not separate items.

### **Patterns of Ship Names: Complex Names:**

Some patterns that combine these elements are well attested. Others may exist as well; again, multiple examples must be used to argue for a pattern not attested here. Each kind of element is discussed above.

**Given Name+Motto/Trait:** Examples include Anne Gallant, Elizabeth Bonaventure, and Mary Grace.

**Given Name+Charge:** Examples include Mary Rose, Peter Pomegranate, and Mary flower.

**Given Name+Captain/Owner's Byname:** Examples include Anne Lisle, Anne Royal, Mary James, Mary Thomas, and Mary Willoughby. In these cases, this is not the full name of an owner, but a different given name with the owner or captain's byname attached..

**Name+Captain/Owner's Byname+Place:** Examples include Anne Gallant of London, the mary bellouse of brystowe, and The George Maynard of London

**Charge+Captain/Owner's Byname:** Examples include Falcon Grey, Falcon Lisle, and Jennet Purwyn.

**Given Name + Place:** Examples include Androwe of Colchester, Cristopher of Bremen, Jesus of Lubeck, James of London, and Mary of Odiern.

**Two Given Names:** Examples include John and Francis, Harry and John, Mary and John, and Michael and John.

**Charge+Place:** Examples include Pelican of Danzig, Falcon of Danzig, Fawcon of Lynne, Greyhound of Dover, Star of Lymehouse, and Unicorn of London.

**Small/Less or Great plus a single element name or (rarely) a two-element name:** Examples include Lesse Barbara, Great Christopher of Bremen, Great Harry, Great Phoenix, Great Susan, and Small Swallow.

### **The Dictionary:**

The dictionary is separated into two sections, royal ships and others. The royal ships are well attested, while the privately owned ships vary greatly. Some are quite famous and appear over many years, others appear in records only once. It's often hard to figure out if identical names refer to the same ship over time or multiple ships. Some of the names of these privately owned ships reflect multiple ships; we're including only the spelling and form variants we can find.

Header spellings are forms close to or identical to modern spellings; they are mostly attested as the names of ships but occasionally only attested in period in other contexts. The date immediately after it is the first date we've been able to find that ship. When a name appears in brackets (like [Advice]), it means that we are unsure if the author of the source has modernized the spellings. In those cases, we're sure that the name content is correct, but are less sure of the spelling. In each case, we're sure that the spellings are compatible with c. 1600 spellings. We hope that over time, we'll be able to remove more and more of those examples.
