

Errata

These are corrections to previous LoARs.

October 1981

Atenveldt

Gabriel René Antoine du Renard. Blazon correction. Azure, a fox passant argent grasping in its sinister forepaw a hunting horn, bell to sinister, and a chief embattled Or.

Listed on the LoAR as a new registration, this was actually a blazon correction from the original August 1979 registration, *Azure, a fox passant argent grasping in its dexter forepaw a hunting horn, bell to sinister, and a chief embattled Or*. The emblazon did not change, and the hunting horn is clearly held in the sinister forepaw, not dexter. When this was done, the O&A labeled the previous device blazon as being retained as a badge. This erroneous badge is released.

October 1986

Atlantia

Ysolde of Summerhall. Device. Per pale vert and Or, two unicornate pegasi rampant addorsed and an escallop inverted within a bordure engrailed, all counterchanged.

Appearing on the October 1986 LoAR as *Per pale vert and Or, two unicornate pegasi rampant addorsed and an escallop within a bordure engrailed, all counterchanged*, the blazon did not specify that the escallop is *inverted*.

November 1987

West

Eliot Hawkes. Badge. Per pale and chevronelly inverted sable and argent, a pink flamingo volant, wings addorsed proper.

Appearing on the November 1987 LoAR as *Per pale and chevronelly inverted sable and argent, a pink flamingo volant proper, wings addorsed proper*, the first *proper* should not have been included in the blazon.

April 1994

Caid

Guillaume de Saint Michel. Device. Azure, an armored foi in chevron issuant from the flanks, on a chief embattled argent three roses proper.

Appearing on the April 1994 with the blazon *Azure, a armored foi in chevron issuant from the flanks, on a chief embattled argent three roses proper*, we are correcting the article to an *armored*.

August 1996

Drachenwald

Andreas Tillman von Severin. Device. Or, a hunting horn gules stringed azure and on a chief checky argent and gules a label of four points azure.

Appearing on the August 1996 with the note "This was registered to the submitter 6/95." This should have appeared under returns rather than acceptances. The device, registered in June 1995, remains registered under the blazon *Or, a hunting horn reversed gules stringed azure and on a chief checky argent and gules a label of four points azure*. The emblazons from June 1995 and August 1996 are identical.

October 2008

Trimaris

Grimdore Hawksbane. Device. Azure, a lightning bolt bendwise Or between an aeolus and a raven rising contourny argent.

Appearing on the October 2008 LoAR as *Azure, a lighting bolt bendwise Or between an aeolus and a raven rising contourny argent*, we are correcting the spelling of *lightning*.

March 2010

Outlands

Adina del Alcázar. Reblazon of device. Purpure, an increscent and on a chief argent a mullet between a pair of drinking horns vert.

Reblazoned in March 2010 as *Purpure, a increscent and on a chief argent a mullet between a pair of drinking horns argent*, the tertiary charges are *vert*, not *argent*. We are also correcting the article to *an increscent*.
